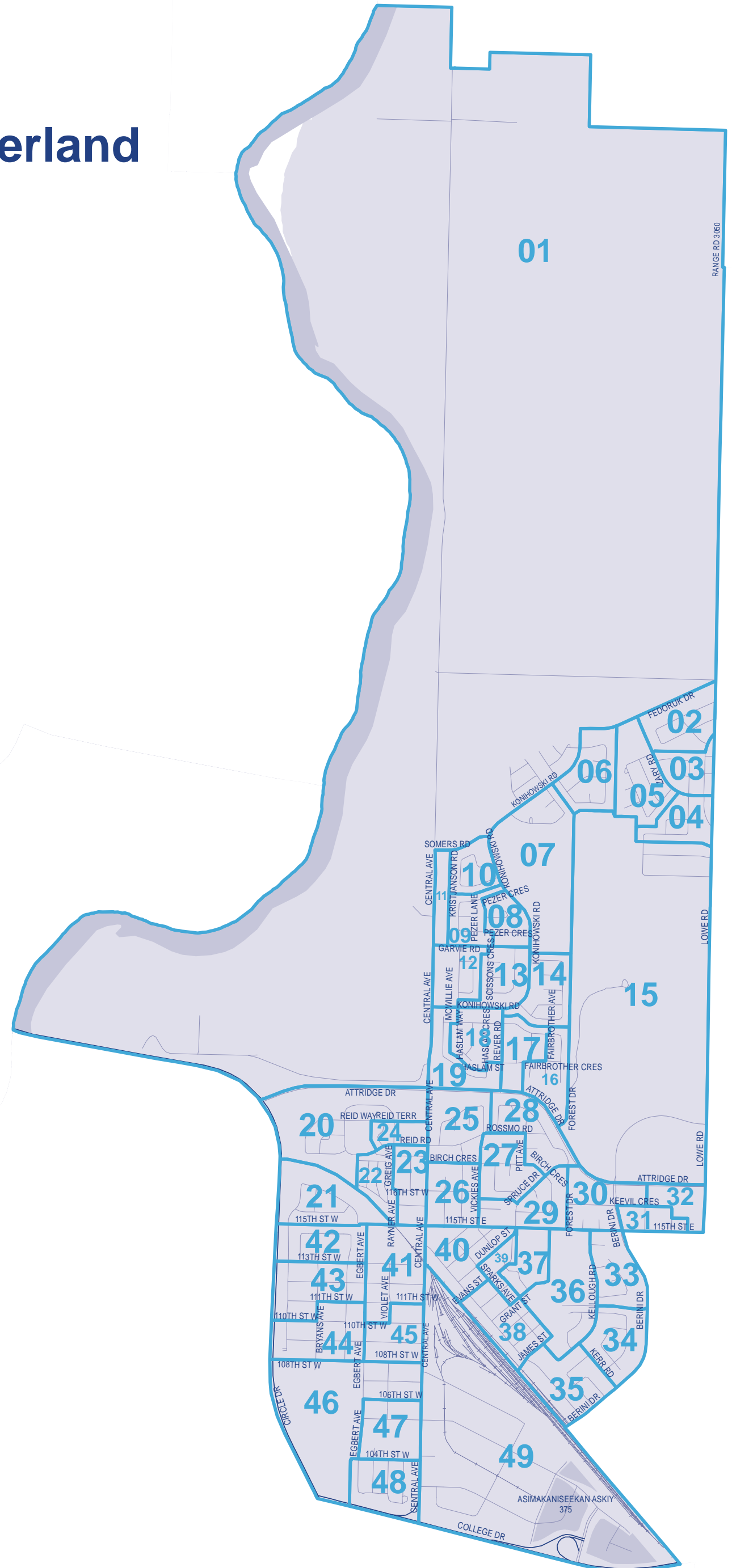
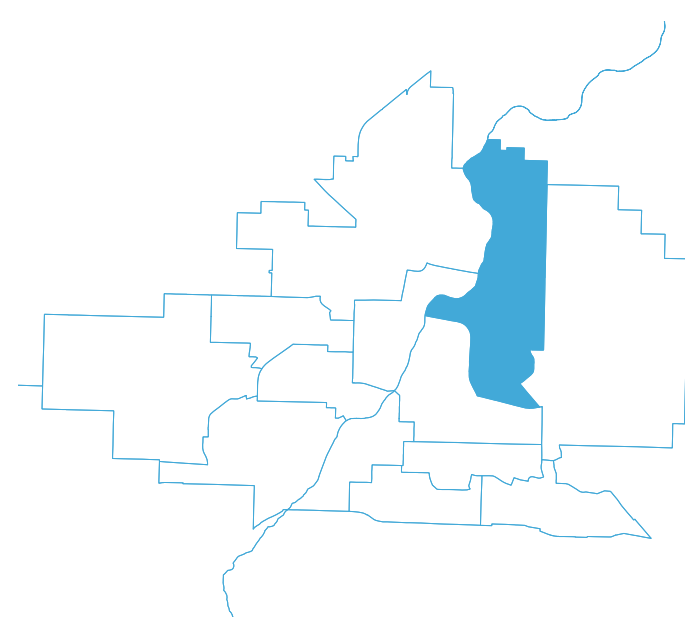
## Constituency of Saskatoon Silverspring-Sutherland

Her Majesty's Writ bearing the date March 8th, 2016, having been directed to me, public notice is now given:

- That I am commanded to cause an election, to be held according to law, of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan for the above-mentioned constituency.
- That I will, on March 19th, 2016, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. attend at 804 Central Avenue, Saskatoon, to receive nominations.
- That in case voting of voters is required, polling places will be open on April 4th, 2016, from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. as follows:

All persons are required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

All times in this proclamation are Central Standard Time.

### Warning

189(1) No person shall unlawfully take down, cover up, mutilate, deface or alter an election proclamation, notice or other document required to be posted pursuant to this Act. Any person violating the provision of subsection 189(1) is guilty of an offence and, subject to subsection 216(2) of this Act, if convicted, is liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to both.
