


Proclamation of the Returning Officer Declaring the Time and Place for the Nomination of Candidates and the Day of Opening the Polling Place


Proclamation

Constituency of Yorkton

Her Majesty's Writ bearing the date March 5th, 2016, having been directed to me, public notice is now given:

- 1. That I am commanded to cause an election, to be held according to law, of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan for the above-mentioned constituency.
- 2. That I will, on March 12th, 2016, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. attend at 32 Smith Street West Yorkton, to receive nominations.
- 3. That in case voting of voters is required, polling places will be open on April 4th, 2016, from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. as follows:





4. That in case voting of voters is required, advance polling places for this constituency will be established at the:

on the following days during the following hours: Tuesday March 29th, 2016 3:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Friday **April 1st, 2016** 3:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Wednesday March 30th, 2016 Saturday **April 2nd, 2016** 12:00 noon to 7:00 p.m. March 31st, 2016 3:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

That mobile polling places will be established on April 4th, 2016 at the following locations during the following hours:

Yorkton & District Nursing Home, 200 Bradbrooke Drive, Yorkton 5:00 p.m. Gladstone Seniors Residence, 162 Dunlop Street West, Yorkton 12:00 noon 9:00 a.m. Aspen Bluffs Villa, 27 Alderwood Place, Yorkton 12:00 noon Clements Court, 141 Henderson Street West, Yorkton 4:00 p.m.

1:00 p.m. Yorkton Regional Health Centre, 270 Bradbrooke Drive, Yorkton 9:00 a.m.

6. That polling places will be established on April 4th, 2016 at the following locations during the following hours:

That at 32 Smith Street West Yorkton, on April 16th, 2016 at 9:00 a.m., I shall open the ballot boxes and, in the case of a general election, I shall open the ballot envelopes containing the ballots of voters at hospitals and remand centres, count those ballots and, where there are absentee voters and displaced voters, open the ballot envelopes containing the ballots and make the addition of the votes given for each candidate and declare elected the candidate having the largest
