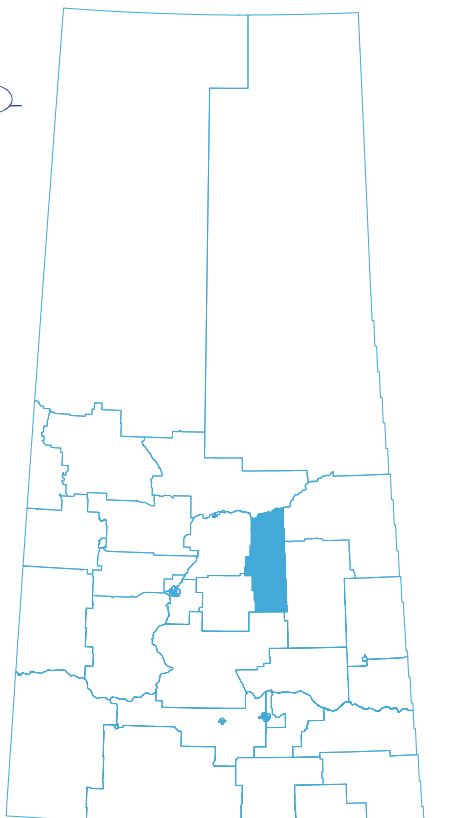
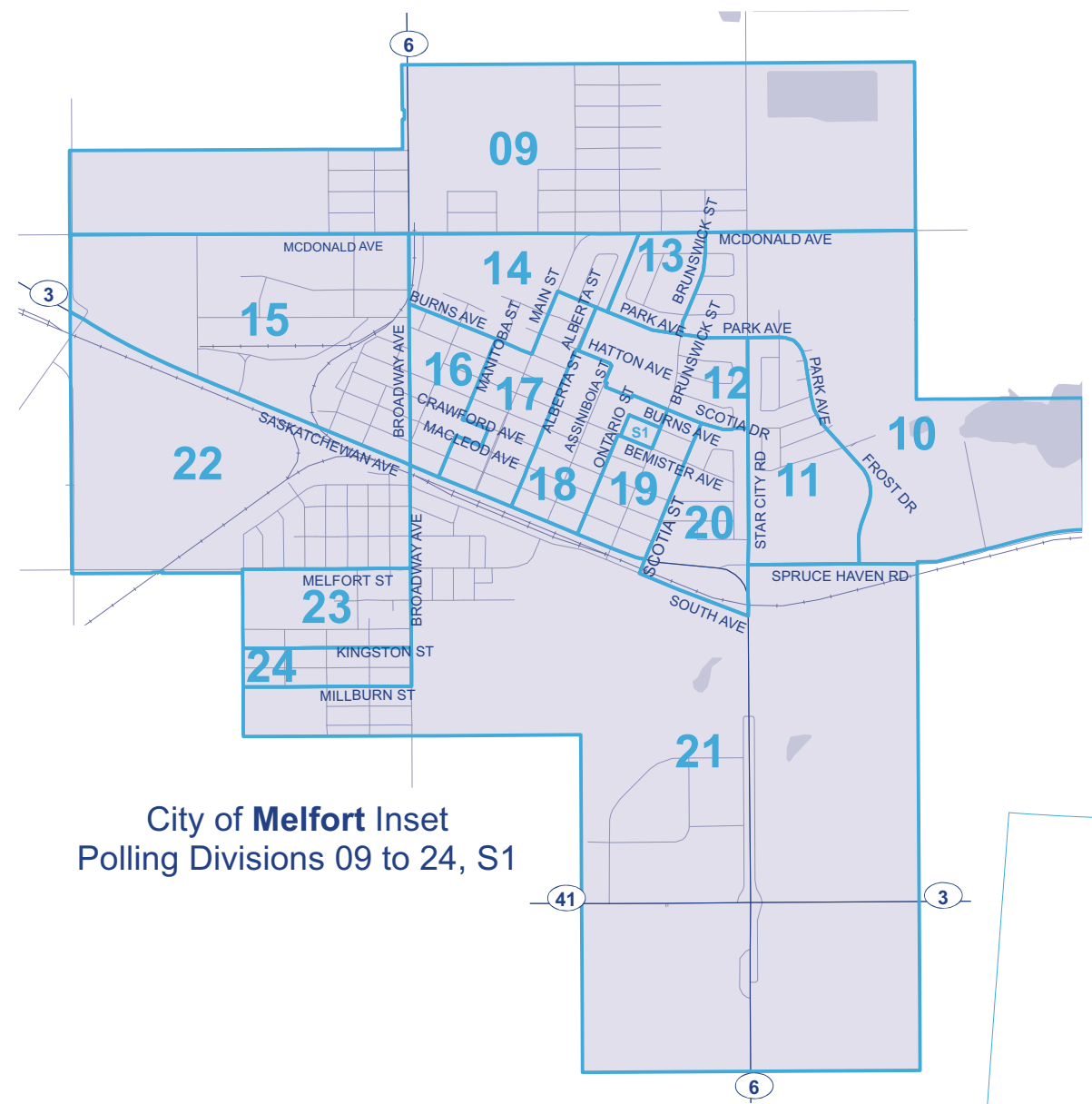
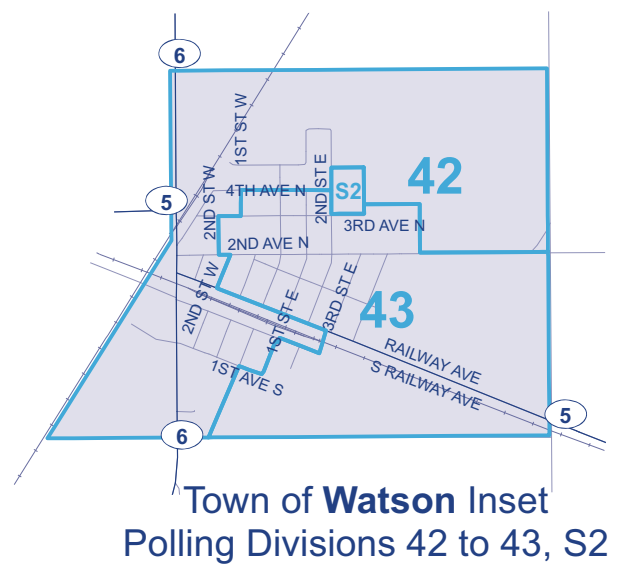
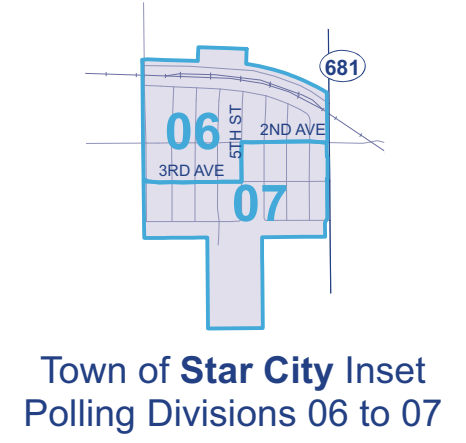
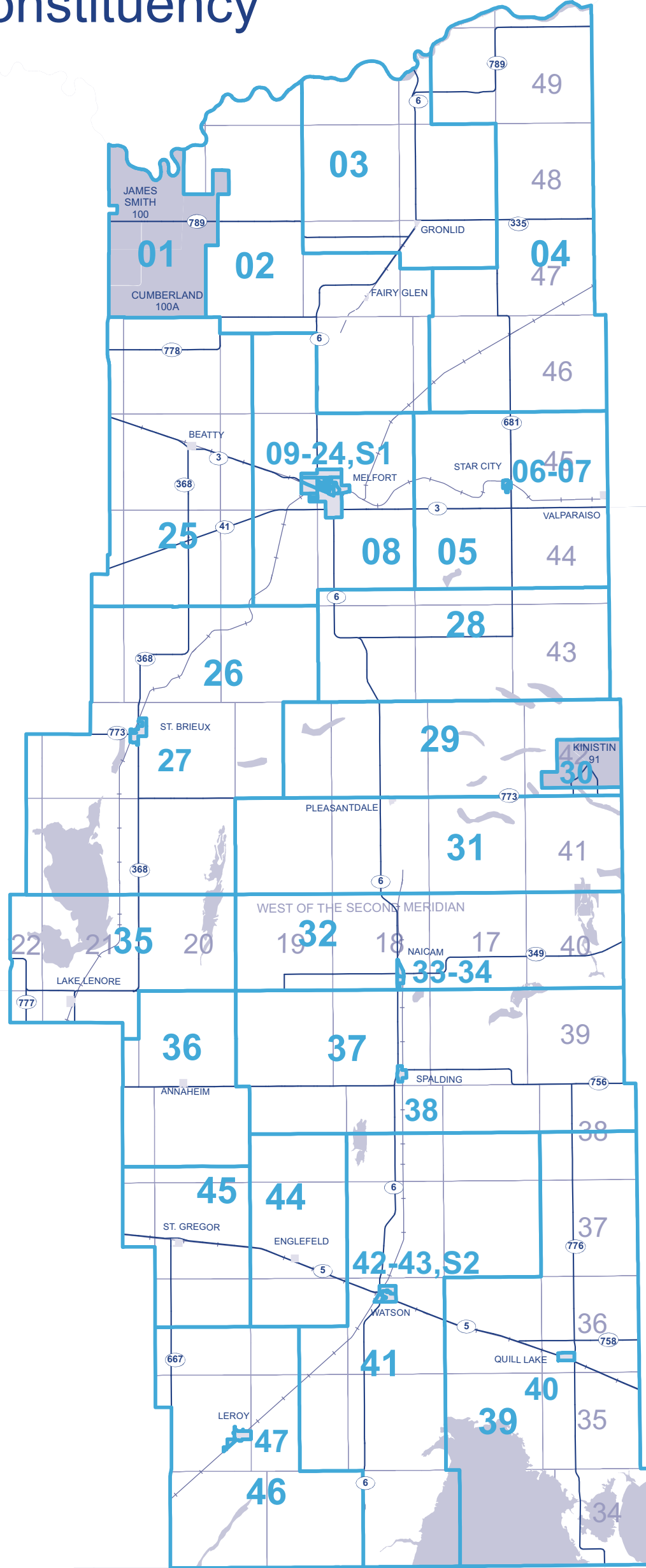
Constituency of Melfort

- That I am commanded to cause an election, to be held according to law, of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan for the above-mentioned constituency.

- That at 215 Main Street, Melfort, on April 16th, 2016 at 9:00 a.m., I shall open the ballot boxes and, in the case of a general election, I shall open the ballot envelopes containing the ballots of voters at hospitals and remand centres, count those ballots and, where there are absentee voters and displaced voters, open the ballot envelopes containing the ballots of those voters and count those ballots and make the addition of the votes given for each candidate and declare elected the candidate having the largest number of votes.

All persons are required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

Warning

189(1) No person shall unlawfully take down, cover up, mutilate, deface or alter an election proclamation, notice or other document required to be posted pursuant to this Act. Any person violating the provision of subsection 189(1) is guilty of an offence and, subject to subsection 216(2) of this Act, if convicted, is liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to both.
