We command you that you do cause:

An Election to be held according to law of a member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan for the Constituency of Athabasca;

The Nomination of Candidates at the election to be held on Saturday the 19th day of March next;

The Voting of Voters to be held, if required, on Monday the 4th day of April;

If voting of voters is required, an advance poll to be held on the following days in the afternoon during the hours mentioned:

- Tuesday the 29th day of March, 2016 from three o'clock to ten o'clock;
- Wednesday the 30th day of March, 2016 from three o'clock to ten o'clock;
- Thursday the 31st day of March, 2016 from three o'clock to ten o'clock;
- Friday the 1st day of April, 2016 from three o'clock to ten o'clock;
- Saturday the 2nd day of April, 2016 from twelve o'clock to seven o'clock;

The Number of Votes cast for the several candidates to be added up on Saturday the 16th day of April;

A Return to the Writ to be made on Wednesday the 27th day of April.
